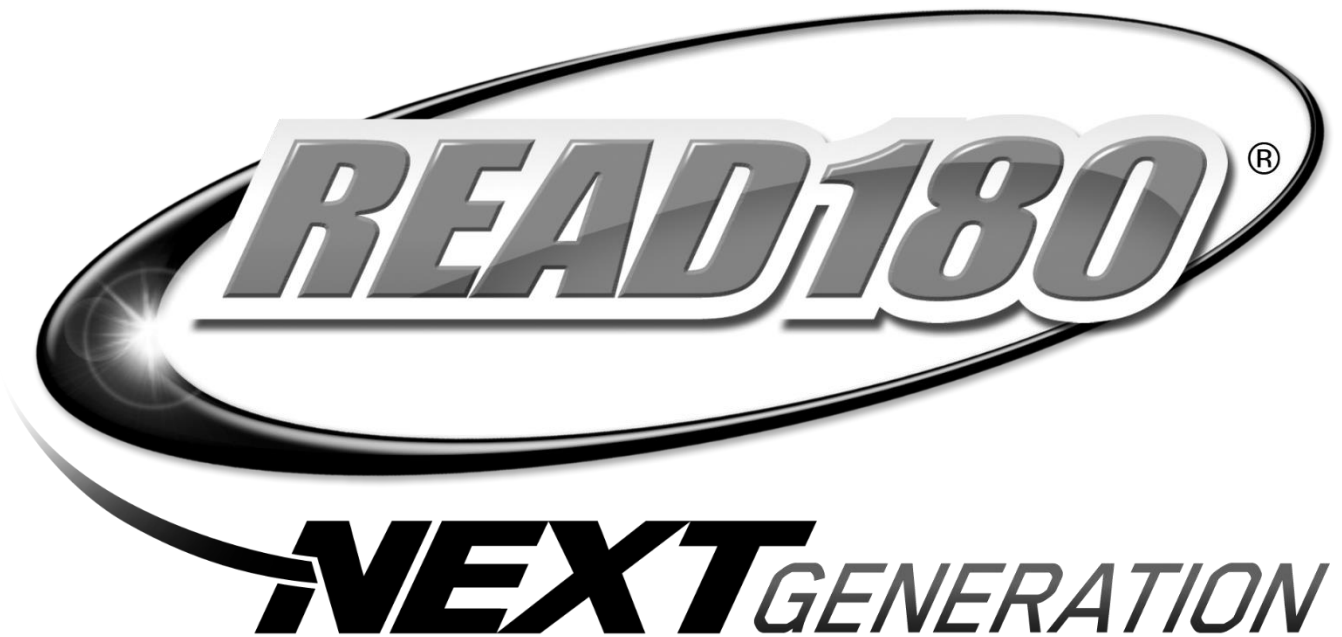

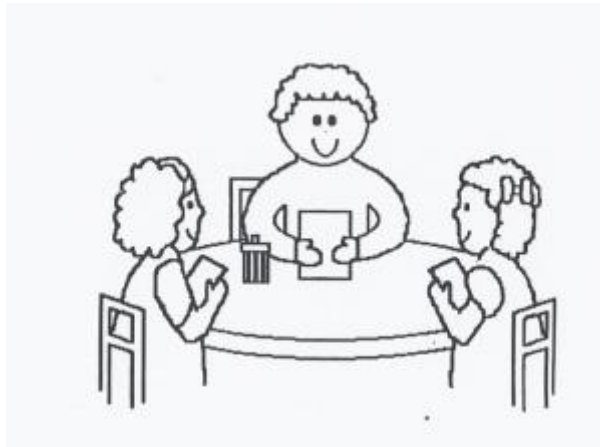

Small Group Instruction

1. Bring your r-book, black binder, and a pen/pencil.
2. Sit down in your assigned seat quietly.
3. Take out your binder and open it to today's assignments for grading.
4. Listen and follow the teacher's instructions.
5. Stay focused on the lesson and complete all written work.
6. Use academic language to answer questions and speak. Good manners please! 😊
7. Submit your completed work for the day for grading at the end of small group instruction.
8. At the end of small group collect all your materials put them away and move to the computer station. If you are at the end of your rotation for the day go to step #9.
9. If you are at the end of the rotation, clean your area, put your materials away, push your chair in and return to your regular class assigned seat.

Computer Station

1. Sit down in your assigned computer seat quietly.
2. Make sure the headphone/microphone is plugged in properly.
3. Log in to the computer using your user name and password.
4. Click on the Read 180 icon



5. Log on to Read 180 using your Read 180 user name and password.
User Name: Your user name is the same as your log on name-but use capital letters!
For Example; SAMUEL.SMITH
Password: (Same number you use to log on from step 2)
6. Click on the Reading icon and follow the instructions.
7. Start by clicking on the Reading task. Follow the instructions. Stay on task! Your persistence will advance you to the next level! You must successfully complete the computer tasks 100% three times in a row to open the Success Zone.
8. Complete the word, spelling and writing tasks every day.
9. When done with the computer, exit Read 180, log off the computer and move to the Reading Station. Be respectful! If you are done with your rotation for the day go to step #9.
10. If you are at the end of the rotation, clean your area, put your materials away, push your chair in and return to your regular class assigned seat.

Reading Station

1. Bring a pencil/pen and your black binder. Make sure your pencil is sharpened before you sit down.
2. Sit in your assigned seat and open your binder.
3. Please be quiet and listen to the teacher's instructions
4. Read the assigned novel with your instructor for the day.
5. Complete the assignment from your novel in your black binder. Be sure to include the date on your assignment.
6. Upon completion of your assignment present your work to the teacher for grading.
7. If you are not done with your written or reading assignment and the buzzer rings, close your black binder, and complete this assignment at the start of the next day's rotation. Notify the instructor you need more time to complete the assignment. 😊
8. Make sure your area is clean and your chair is pushed in.
9. Move to the Small Group Instruction Station when you have completed the computer rotation for today. If you are at the end of your rotation for the day go to step #10.
10. If you are at the end of the rotation, clean your area, put your materials away, push your chair in and return to your regular class assigned seat.

Taking the SRI Test



Computer Station Procedures

1. Sit down in your assigned computer seat quietly.

5. Log on to Read 180 using your Read 180 user name and password.

6. Click on the SRI icon and follow the listening instructions. 
7. **Take the SRI test seriously! It will determine your reading level (lexile level.)**
8. When done with the SRI exit Read 180 on the computer screen. Log on to the Read 180 Computer Station if you have time and complete the Reading Zones. If you have more rotations go to today go to step #9. If you are done with your rotations for the day, go to step #10.
9. Log off the computer and wait for the next rotation. Make sure you push your chair in and leave your area clean! Be respectful and have good computer manners!
10. If you are at the end of the rotation, clean your area, put your materials away, push your chair in and return to your regular class assigned seat.

Reading Counts Book Test

Computer Station Procedures

1. Make sure the headphone/microphone is plugged in!
2. Log in to the computer using your user name and password.

3. Click on the Read 180 icon



4. Log on to Read 180 using your Read 180 user name and password.

User Name: Your user name is the same as your log on name-but use capital letters!)

For Example; SAMUEL.SMITH

Password: (Same number you use to log on from step 2)

5. Click on the Reading Counts icon and follow the instructions.
6. Type in the title of your book! The computer will search for the book. Click on the title to get started.
7. **Take the Book test seriously! It will determine your reading (lexile) level.**
8. When done with the Reading Counts Test exit Read 180 on the computer screen. Log on to the Read 180 Computer Station if you have time and complete the Reading Zones. If you have no more time go to step #9.
9. Log off the computer and wait for the next rotation. Make sure you push your chair in and leave your area clean! Be respectful and have good computer manners! If you are done with your rotations for the day, go to step #10.
10. If you are at the end of the rotation, clean your area, put your materials away, push your chair in and return to your regular class assigned seat.
